National Support and Resource Guide for Women and Child Survivors of Violence: Shelter Homes, OCCs & Emergency Hotlines

As Bangladesh is becoming more digital and developing in various sectors, a crucial question arises: has this progress translated into meaningful changes in the domestic violence landscape? The 2024 BBS–UNFPA Violence Against Women Survey paints a concerning picture. Although 76% of women experience intimate partner violence, more than half-51.5%-remain unaware of where to report such abuse. Urban awareness marginally exceeds rural awareness, yet both remain critically low.

The survey shows the Local police station is overwhelmingly the most recognized authority. Among women who know where to report violence, 91% mentioned their local police station. Other avenues are far less known. Only 32% mentioned Union or Upazila Parishads. 13% pointed out village mediators and just 10% to courts.

Knowledge of specialized services remains critically low. One Stop Crisis Centre despite operating for over 20 years are known to only 2% of women nationwide. Only 12% know about the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs Helpline 109 while 45% know 999. The least informed are often those most vulnerable: divorced, separated, and widowed women.

If essential helplines and support mechanisms fail to reach marginalized victims-who represent the highest proportion of survivors- our national efforts risk becoming ineffective. For this reason, ANUKUL has compiled this resource guide that brings together information on Crisis Centres (OCCs), shelter homes, emergency hotlines, and specialized services offered by government institutions and NGOs to support survivors of violence.

Victim Support Centre (VSC) - Dhaka Metropolitan Police:

Who are the Victims?

The Victim Support Centre (VSC) supports the following groups:

- (a) Victims in cases/lawsuits.
- (b) Missing children (females of any age, male children up to 4 years of age).

- (c) Women and children who have left home in anger.
- (d) Domestic workers subjected to abuse.
- (e) Women and children with disabilities.
- (f) Other victims.

The VSC provides services such as:

- Emergency residential facilities for victims.
- Immediate assistance like medical aid and psychological counseling.
- Shelter for a maximum of 05 (five) days during the crisis period.
- Provision of food and a secure environment for the victim.
- Handover of missing children to their guardians; if guardians are not found, they are sent to an NGO for rehabilitation.
- Services provided by female police members, lawyers, counselors, and doctors in a woman-friendly environment.

Women Support Activities are conducted in 6 divisional cities of Bangladesh: Dhaka, Chattogram, Rajshahi, Khulna, Barisal, and Sylhet. This program offers 2 types of services:

- 1. Legal Aid (Women Repression Prevention Cell).
- 2. Shelter Provision (Women Support Center).

Shelter Services

Through these centers, abused and homeless women are provided free shelter for up to 6 (six) months until their complaint/case is settled. With the approval of the Director-General, Department of Women Affairs, this period can be extended by 3 more months, and with the approval of the Ministry, by another 3 (three) months, for a total of 1 (one) year. Women can be accompanied by up to two children under 12 years of age. Additionally, they are provided with free food, clothing, medical care, and primary education. To facilitate their rehabilitation into society, they are given free training in various trades (sewing, cutting, wool knitting, and embroidery) during their stay at the center.

National Trauma Counselling Centre: at the Department of Women Affairs Building, to provide mental health support to the women and children victims of violence

Objectives of the NTCC

- -Provide psycho-social counseling support for women and children of NTCC, OCC and Safe home.
- -Conduct different types of psycho-social counseling training for Human Resource Development.
- -Organize awareness raising programmes such as observing World Mental Health Day.
